Getting Started Tips & Tricks

- The IP addresses on UPLINK1 and DEV1 can't be in the same subnet.
- The IP address on DEV1 should be in the same subnet as your equipment.
- For advanced 3G/4G configuration, navigate to the System -> UPLINK2 in the SiteManager GUI.
- If there is no agent available for your equipment, see the "Sniffer agent" guide on our support site.
- Make sure you have administrator rights in order to install run LinkManager

1 SiteManager Configuration



A. Install the Appliance Launcher on your PC Download from: http://info.secomea.com/appliance-launcher

B. Unbox the SiteManager

C. Connect the UPLINK1 or DEV1 port directly to your PC, and power on the SiteManager. (12-24 Volt DC) When the STATUS LED is steady red, start the Appliance Launcher software.



After the SiteManager is configured, make sure it has internet connection and the status LED is steady green.

A. From the GateManager, click the SiteManager GUI button to open the web interface of the SiteManager. Navigate to GateManager -> Agents and create an agent suitable for your equipment.



B. Install the LinkManager on your PC. Download from: http://support.secomea.com/download-linkmanager

C. Start the LinkManager. It will launch in your browser once ready. Login with the LinkManager certificate and password you have received by email.

Connect to the agent of the SiteManager.



Once you have connected to an agent with your LinkManager, start using your programming software.



B. Once logged into the GateManager, follow the startup wizard, to create a LinkManager user.
